Sports premium 2013-14 evaluation.

The funding and training by Mrs Stocks has enabled all teachers to develop their own subject knowledge around gym. Especially focussing on progression and safety aspects.

We have used the funding to allow time to improve medium term planning for PE and have developed consistent assessment sheet in line with other subjects.

This year with the funding and in partnership with Mrs Stocks we have held intraschool multiskills competition for years 1 and 2. The whole school in year groups held a football tournament to consolidate our Geography theme week on the world cup.

The children have taken part in a variety of interschool competitions which have been valuable for all.

Mrs Daw has run a high energy fitness club at lunchtime promoting girls fitness and general health and wellbeing.

The use of specialist coaches has meant the staff could watch experts teach lessons to develop their own subject knowledge and skills when teaching PE.

Replacing and buying new equipment has been valuable in ensuring correct safety and increased participation as they don't have to wait for their turn.
