

# Topic Learning - Under the Sea

**Why are sea turtles an endangered species?**

Suggested Activities to choose from. <b>You do not have to do all these activities!</b>	
Key Stage 1	Key Stage 2
<p>1) Draw and label the life cycle of a sea turtle. This animal is a reptile; it is cold blooded and it lays its eggs on the land.</p> <p>2) Talk about which materials we can recycle at home. How could we reduce the amount of plastic that we use? Did you know that plastic is very dangerous to sea turtles? Large amounts of plastic end up in the sea. Some sea turtles think the plastic is their food and try to eat it! Often they are tangled up in the plastic and old nets and can't swim.</p> <p>4) Locate and name the oceans of the world on a world map. Find the Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, Arctic and Southern oceans.</p> <p>5) Create your own sea picture and include a range of sea creatures OR make your own rainbow fish to give to someone.</p>	<p>1) Find out about sea turtles and their habitats. Which oceans of the world do they live in? Locate these on a world map.</p> <p>2) What are plastic islands or "garbage patches"? What affect is plastic having on the lives of sea turtles and other sea creatures? What could you do to help? Make something out of a plastic bottle. See the website in KS1 list for ideas.</p> <p>3) Make an information booklet or information page about sea turtles or other endangered sea creatures. Explain what is happening to these animals and try to persuade your reader to use less plastic and recycle more.</p> <p>4) Make up a song or poem about the sea. This could be about saving a sea creature or describe the sea as a beautiful home for sea creatures. Use adjectives and adverbs to make your poem interesting.</p> <p>5) Illustrate your poem or your booklet. Draw sea creatures in detail. Look closely at their features.</p>
