3	Log on to Education City maths play the games under the homework tab – summer term. Don't forget TT rock stars is available too.





English (remember to use your neat cursive handwriting) You can use your home learning book to write this in.


1	Learn 5 new spellings from your spelling list. Check off the spellings your child knows. Encourage your child to use the spellings in the back of their book in their writing
2	Find an underwater picture. Describe what you would see if you were a diver. MUST: Use capital letters and full stops in a full sentence. SHOULD: use exciting adjectives to describe and commas in a list. COULD: Use exciting ways to open your sentences and use adverbs to explain how the animals move under the water. Behind the shipwreck was a beautiful, green turtle swimming slowly towards the pink coral.
3	Find a sea animal you are interested in. Write a fact file about the animal. MUST: Write in sentences and include simple information. SHOULD: Write in sentences and include information about what the animal eats, where it lives, what it looks like and what is in its food chain. COULD: Use sub headings to organise your work.

Reading Try to read a little everyday.


1	Choose your book of the week by going to the Oxford Owl website https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/ ,– you could look for a story following the theme of ‘Under the Sea,’ ‘Jellyfish shoes’, ‘Deep down weird’, ‘The seagull’, ‘The secret whirlpool’, ‘Ant’s Pact’, ‘The Contest’ are a few that may be useful.
2	Listen to “The Rainbow Fish” on “Storyline online”– Why didn't the other fish want to play with the Rainbow fish? Talk about the message of the story about sharing and making friends. How does it make you feel when you share? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=r9mryuEKkKc
3	Practise reading and spelling your year 2 tricky words – can you make a game with the words like matching pairs or a bingo game? Or print out a word search on twinkl https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-l-526927-year-2-common-exception-words-word-search-activity-pack

- Fold into two equal parts.
- Take 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, or 28 counters/ sweets/ raisins/ buttons etc.
- Share the objects equally between the four parts. Make sure the children count them out in a one for you, one for you, one for you manner!
- One part is $\frac{1}{2}$ so $\frac{1}{2}$ of 4 = 2



- Fold into four equal parts.

- Share the objects equally between the four parts. Make sure the children count them out in a one for you, one for you, one for you manner!
- One part is $\frac{1}{4}$ so $\frac{1}{4}$ of 4 = 1
