Perhaps you have been letting your younger brother or sister choose what to watch on TV, even if you don't really like their choice!

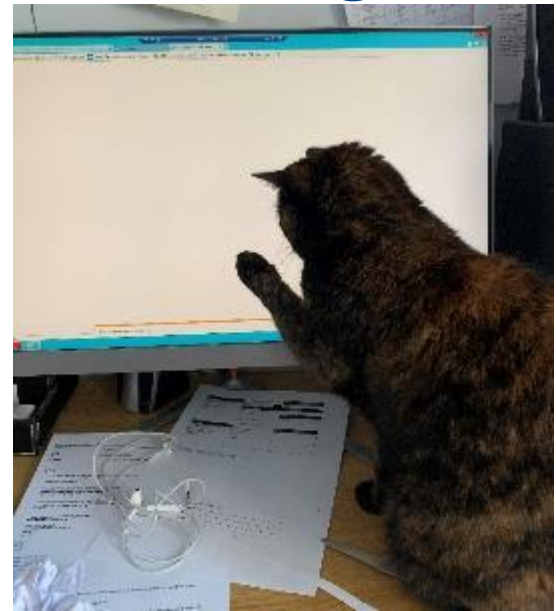


Maybe you have let your grown up do their work before helping you with your home-learning, even when you have really wanted to get started!
