

## **Mrs Howlett's Maths Challenge 8<sup>th</sup> June 2020**

This week's challenge is a set of word problems. You will need to use addition to solve the problems. Write a number sentence to show how you worked out the answer:

**e.g. Theo has 2 biscuits. His mum gives him 1 more. How many does he have now?**

$$2 + 1 = 3$$

**Michael has 5 apples. He finds 3 more of them. How many does he have now?**

**Oliver is 7 years old and Kate is 3 years older. How old is Kate?**

**Jade has 6 chocolates and James has 12 chocolates. How many chocolates do they have altogether?**

**There are 14 girls in the class, and 15 boys. How many children are there altogether?**

**Lorna has 15 books. She has 5 books fewer than Daniel. How many books does Daniel have?**

**Oliver has 24 songs saved on his MP3 player. Imogen has 16 more songs than Oliver. How many songs does Imogen have?**

**A teacher has 20 felt tip pens. She borrows 35 pens from the classroom next door. How many pens does she have now?**

### **Extension:**

**Now write some of your own word problems, where the numbers need to be added together. Challenge your parent, carer or a sibling to answer your questions. 😊**
