<p>1) <u>Geography</u>: What would you like to see in the world of the future? Talk about what you would change if you could. Share your ideas by making a poster showing your ideas. The poster might have the title; CARE FOR YOUR WORLD</p> <p>2) <u>History</u>: If you were to travel in time where would you most like to go? Find out some information about the past and record your ideas any way you want. - You could visit Egyptians, Knights and Castles, Pre-historic (dinosaurs) or you might like to meet a famous person or royalty from the past.</p> <p>3) <u>Science</u>: Jumping to the future draw, paint, collage Imagine a new species of animal - what features might it have to help it survive in the future? Would there be any unusual plants in the future? You could draw or make a collage.</p> <p>4) <u>D&T</u>: Design your own time travel machine. What would you make it of? What gadgets might it have? What controls might you need? - draw plans or make a model, turn your room or make a den into a time machine!</p> <p>5) <u>Art</u> Draw plans or a create a picture, collage or make a junk box model of one of the following: A futuristic mode of transport, a toy, an outfit to wear, a hairstyle, a city, a home or your bedroom of the future.</p> <p>6) <u>Music</u>: Ask your parents about music of their past - what did they like listening to? Listen to it yourself. What do you think?</p>	<p>1) <u>Geography</u>: In the distant past all the land on earth was in one big continent called 'Pangaea'. Over 175 million years, the land split into the 7 continents of Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America and South America we see now. Imagine what a map of the world might look like 175 million years into the future. How many continents would there be then? What would they look like? Draw and label your own map of this future world.</p> <p>2) <u>History</u>: Lots of amazing things we take for granted now were invented in the last 30 years. Things like smartphones, text messages, flat screen TVs, Youtube, Wifi and online shopping didn't exist 30 years ago! Make a list of some of your favourite technologies and look up when they were invented. What kind of technologies might we invent in the next 30 years, or 100 years? Flying cars? Jetpacks? Think up some amazing inventions of the future, draw pictures of them and write about them.</p> <p>3) <u>Science: Creative Thinking Challenges!</u> (see PPT slides below as a starter for these...) <u>Prediction Key</u>: How might animals (including humans) evolve in the future...? <u>Reverse-Listing Key</u>: List 10 animals that will never become extinct and justify why... <u>Disadvantages Key</u>: What if people in the future had no noses?! Why might this happen? List 10 disadvantages of having a sense of smell...</p> <p>4) <u>Art</u> Create a futuristic landscape for Verwood / a city / a beach / a space-city Make a silhouette futuristic city-scape with black paper on a sunset background.</p>

5) DT:

What would a time machine look like? Design and build a time machine out of junk modelling materials. What will the outside be made of? What will the inside look like? How will you control where in time your machine goes? What will the 'brains' of your time machine look like? If you have a big enough box you could even make a life size one!

6) Music:

Create a musical soundtrack for how a time machine might sound whilst launching.

Brainstorm what you might see on a trip to the future. Turn it into a rap with sound effects.


